

Anything's Pawsible Class Policies

General Rules and Policies pertaining to all classes and private lessons held at Anything's Pawsible.

Detailed class schedules will be distributed at the first class for 2 and 8-week classes.

For each class, you'll need to bring

- 🐾 A positive attitude
- 🐾 Your clicker and your dog's favorite toys and/or treats
- 🐾 A bowl and water for your dog
- 🐾 Your 3-ring binder with class information in it
- 🐾 A signed liability waiver for each **new** adult or child guest you bring
- 🐾 A flat (snap or buckle) collar for your dog, or martingale/greyhound collar. No other collar types permitted. Head halters may be worn on the property but may NOT be used on or around the agility equipment as they pose a safety risk. Leash must be 4-6 feet.
- 🐾 Shade (optional) - there is little-to-no natural shade available. You are welcome to bring your own tent, canopy, or umbrella for shade but may not set it up within the fenced area.
- 🐾 Chair (optional) - if you'd like to sit between your runs
- 🐾 Dog crate or Exercise pen - (particularly for agility classes) once we begin sequencing obstacles together, it may be necessary to walk the course without your dog. These are both acceptable methods of confining your dog during these times or in between turns.

Property Rules

- 🐾 No smoking allowed on the property.
- 🐾 Do not park in the grass. You can park on the driveway back by the barn.
- 🐾 Dogs must remain confined (crate or ex-pen) or on a 4-6 ft. leash when not working.
- 🐾 Please pick up after your dog. If you are found to not be picking up after your dog, you may be asked to leave and no money refunded. Poop bags and/or a poop scoop are provided. **It is your responsibility to make sure your dog is pottied prior to the start of class, and as frequently as necessary to avoid accidents in the training area.**
- 🐾 Please keep all gates CLOSED and securely latched.
- 🐾 The non-training buildings on the property are off limits unless you have instructor permission.
- 🐾 Unfortunately, we do not have restroom facilities available on the property. Restrooms are available in Alto and Russiaville (both approximately 2 miles away).

General Lesson Policies

- 🐾 There are no stupid questions! It is my job to present the material in a way that makes sense to you. Please help me do that by letting me know if something isn't clear.
- 🐾 Please be respectful of your fellow students and avoid disruptive behaviors.
- 🐾 Arrive 5-10 minutes early for your lesson so you and your dog are ready when class starts.
- 🐾 Lesson plans will be handed out for 2 and 8-week classes for students to know what's coming up.

"Testing Out" of Prerequisites

If you wish to attempt to test out of a prerequisite class, you must schedule a private lesson. Test-out sessions that take 20 minutes or less will cost \$15. Test-out sessions over 20 minutes are \$30.

Payments

2-week classes and 8-week classes must be paid for at or prior to the first class. 2-week classes are \$20/topic. 8-week classes are \$96/8 weeks. On-going classes (f.ex. Advanced Agility) are \$12/week, to be paid before the end of class. Private lessons are \$30/hour, to be paid before the end of class.

Refunds

There are no refunds for private lessons or 2-week classes. For 8-week classes: Students wishing to withdraw from the class between the 1st and 3rd class sessions will receive 50% of their **remaining** class balance. Withdrawals after the 3rd session will result in no money refunded.

Attendance

For private lessons, 2-week classes, and 8-week classes, please notify your instructor in advance if you will be missing class. For Advanced Agility, please notify your instructor in advance of attending class. You are responsible for obtaining homework for any missed classes prior to the next class session.

Cancellations

The instructor may deem conditions unsafe for lessons and cancel classes due to weather, footing, humidity, etc. Unless cancelling less than 2 hours prior to the start of class, the cancellation will be sent via email. Students are responsible for checking for updates/cancellations. **Please confirm receipt of a class change.** Lessons will not be held when the wind-chill is below 32 degrees Fahrenheit, or the heat index is above 90 degrees Fahrenheit.

Guests and Children

All children under 16 years of age must have a parent or guardian present to supervise them (who is not participating in the lesson). Exceptions may be allowed on a case-by-case basis - contact your instructor. All guests must sign a liability waiver.

Anything's Pawsible Clothing

Anything's Pawsible clothing items in various sizes, styles, and colors are available for purchase. Notices will be sent out periodically - contact Jenn for details!

Change of Policies
